STUDENT SOCIAL ACTIVITY AT THE FACULTY OF PSYCHOLOGY AND COGNITIVE SCIENCE

Appreciating and promoting the social engagement of students at the Faculty of Psychology and Cognitive Science of Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań, we present a pilot program for reporting and scoring activities that go beyond academic courses and scientific work. The aim of the program is to encourage active participation in faculty life and support social initiatives. A detailed (but not exhaustive) list of activities with corresponding points, presented in the table below, includes organizational activities, volunteering, academic knowledge dissemination, and other forms of active participation in faculty life. The most engaged students will be recognized annually during the faculty's inauguration of the new academic year and awarded during the graduation ceremony. The student's involvement, along with the number of hours, will be included in the diploma supplement.

The points assigned to each activity reflect the level of engagement, the significance of the activity for the Faculty, its impact on the academic and local community, and the range of social skills developed. The scoring system results from extensive discussions among the program's developers (teachers and the Student Government Council of the Faculty). The maximum number of points for a single activity is 20, while the minimum is 1.

Every student of the Faculty of Psychology and Cognitive Science AMU can submit their activities via the following form:  <https://kleka-iskra.web.amu.edu.pl/formularz>. The form requires details such as name, email address, student ID number, activity (selected from a list), a brief description, and the email address of a person who can confirm the reported activity, along with its date and duration (e.g., the supervisor of a student organization, event organizer). Submissions can be sent throughout the academic year (except during vacation period). Reporting starts from the academic year 2024/2025. The same activities cannot be reported twice, for instance, tasks performed as part of a specific function (e.g., class representative) should not be reported separately as volunteering. Activities not listed in the table can also be submitted.
